Dear Mr. Upham:

On July 27, 2010, Michael D'Angelo, President/CEO, BMDC, LLC, on behalf of Energy Professionals, LLC, filed with the Commission an application for registration as a natural gas aggregator, together with the initial application fee of \$250.00. On August 9, 2010, Energy Professionals, LLC filed with the Commission an amended application for registration as a natural gas aggregator.

The Commission has reviewed the application for registration as a natural gas aggregator and has determined that it meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02. Therefore, the Commission will approve Energy Professionals, LLC as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to be effective August 13, 2010. This registration will expire at the end of business on August 10, 2012.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02 (e), each aggregator applicant shall re-register with the Commission every 2 years by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of Energy Professionals, LLC, on or before June 12, 2012. Pursuant to Puc 3003.02 (d), each natural gas aggregator shall notify any LDC in whose service territory it intends to do business of the filing of its registration or renewal application at the time it files such an application with the Commission. 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All registered Natural Gas Aggregators in the State of New Hampshire are subject to specific requirements spelled out in N.H. Code Admin.
