

Reference is made to your secretarial letter dated April 25, 2011, in which the Commission approved Staff's request for a suspension of the procedural schedule on this docket pending confirmation of the Tioga River Water Company, Inc.'s (Tioga's) compliance with Commission Audit Staff's requirements related to its internal recordkeeping. In light of Tioga's continuing efforts toward compliance with these requirements, Staff requests that the suspension of the procedural schedule on this docket be extended until July 15, 2011, to provide for Staff's monitoring of Tioga's progress.
