On August 27, 2010, Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) filled a petition pursuant to RSA 37.17 for a license to reconstruct and maintain electric lines and a fiber optic cable across the Cocheco River in Dover, New Hampshire PSNH filled supplemental information on September 23, 2010, PSNH stated that the reconstruction of the M-183 115kV line crossing is necessary to meet the reasonable requirements of service to the public due to load growth in the sea coast area. PSNH sad that the in-service date for this project is November 12, 2010, and that construction is planned to coincide with an ISO New England Inc. 2010, and that construction is planned to coincide with an ISO New England Inc. Scinduled outage of that begins on October 30, 2010.

In support of its petition. PSNH filled the following exhibits: a plan depicting the gographic location of the crossing (Exhibit I), as plan and projected elevations of the proposed crossing (Exhibit II), and construction detail drawings of the 15kV Transmission Standard Dead End Structure Type E (Figure I) and the 15kV Transmission Standard Dead End Structure Type DA (Figure 2).
