Dear Ms. Howland.

Enclosed is the January and February 2011` reconciliation report. The January report is late due to a lack of sufficient data to complete the report. We have had trouble getting our natural gas invoice (cost and use) from our new supplier and have only just recently as of the week of March 28th been able to get everything straightened out for the January gas bill with the supplier. We are going to be much more aggressive in requiring them to get us an invoice to work with so that we have time to get this report completed and submitted on time. They did get February invoice to us in a timely manner. February is late because we've had some concerns with the data that was being used and have spent the last week reviewing that data, we are now confident with the data we are submitting. We will not be changing the COE charge. The current March 2011 energy charge is \$16.64/mlb. The rate in April 2011 is to remain unchanged at \$16.64/mlb.
