
On September 14, 2010, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Soltage MGTCO 1, LLC (Soltage) on behalf of Saint Lukes Community Services, LLC requesting certification for the Saint Lukes Lifeworks photovoltaic facility as a Class II renewable energy source pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Staff has reviewed your application and has noted the following items that must be addressed before your application is considered complete:

- 1.) Appendix A: Who manually enters the electrical generation data into the NEPOOL GIS website and periodically tests the Shark 100 meters for accuracy pursuant with ANSI C12.20 and IEC 687 standards?
- 2.) Please provide the name and contact information of the independent monitor or third party meter reader who monitors and verifies the electricity produced by the facility but is used by Saint Lukes.
- 3.) Please provide documentation that the independent monitor referred to in your responses above has been certified by the state of Connecticut as a third party meter reader.

4.) Is the Saint Lukes facility certified under another state's renewable portfolio standard program? If so, please provide documentation.

These items must be received by the Commission to complete your application. Until such time, it will not be processed. If the requested documentation is not provided within ten business days, your file will be closed without prejudice. Please refer to docket number DE 10-247 in all future correspondence with the Commission. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
