On August 5, 2015¹, Glacial Energy of New England, Inc. (Glacial Energy) filed a Form E-2500 Annual Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) Compliance Report for the 2014 compliance year. Pursuant to Puc 2503.03(a) and RSA 362-F:8, the report was required to be filed on or before July 1, 2014. Pursuant to Puc 2503.03(c) and RSA 362-F:10, II, any alternative compliance payments (ACPs) due were required to be paid to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) at the same time as the due date for filing of the Annual RPS Compliance Report. The initial report was filed 35 days late, and to date, the Commission has not received the ACPs due from Glacial Energy for compliance year 2014. The report indicated that ACPs in the total aggregate sum of \$374,470 were due from Glacial Energy for 2014.

Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order directing Glacial Energy to pay to the Commission ACPs in the total aggregate sum of \$374,470 for the 2014 RPS compliance year, within 30 days of the date of the order.
