Exhibit PSNH-5 - Please provide the amounts of the distribution rate increases that took place on August 1, 2009 and July 1, 2010

Response:

In Docket No. DE 09-035, PSNH's annual distribution rate level was increased by \$25.6 million under a temporary rate increase effective August 1, 2009 (Order No. 24,997) and by \$45.5 million under a permanent rate increase effective July 1, 2010 (Order No. 25,123). The distribution rate changes resulted in an average 2.7% residential rate increase on August 1, 2009, and an average 5.1% residential rate increase on July 1, 2010.
