Dear Mr. Newman:

On October 7, 2010, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received two applications from Tioga Solar Westborough, LLC (Tioga Solar) on behalf of BJ's Wholesale Club, Inc. requesting certification for the BJ's Wholesale Club photovoltaic (PV) facilities as Class II renewable energy sources pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law. These applications include rooftop mounted PV facilities located in Leominster and Attleboro, Massachusetts. Staff has reviewed your applications and has noted the following items that must be addressed before your applications are considered complete:

- 1.) When did each facility begin operation, e.g. install a revenue quality meter?
- 2.) Please provide a signed interconnection agreement for each facility.
- 3.) Is the independent monitor identified on line 17 of your applications certified as a third party meter reader in Massachusetts or the NEPOOL GIS? If yes, please provide documentation verifying certification.

- 4.) Since the independent monitor is located in California, who manually enters the electric generation data into the NEPOOL GIS website and periodically tests the revenue quality meters for accuracy pursuant to NE-ISO standards?
- 5.) Please provide the NEPOOL GIS facility code number for each facility.
- 6.) Are the facilities certified under another state's renewable portfolio standard program? If yes, please provide documentation verifying certification.

These items must be received by the Commission to complete your applications. Until such time, they will not be processed. If the requested documentation is not provided within ten business days, your files will be closed without prejudice. Please refer to docket numbers DE 10-266 (Leominster facility) and DE 10-267 (Attleboro facility) in all future correspondence with the Commission.
