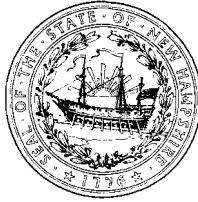

Re: DM 10-273, Notification of E Source Companies LLC's Intent to Provide Electric Aggregation Service

Dear Mr. Sunshine:

This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received E Source Companies LLC's (ESource) notice of intent to provide electric aggregation service in the State of New Hampshire, pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Rules Puc 2003.04. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.04. Based on Staff's recommendation and the Commission's review, the Commission approves ESource's application to provide electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.

Please note the following provision of 2003.05 (f): "[E]ach approved aggregator shall re-notify the commission after the initial 2 year period, or after the 5 year renewal period as applicable, by filing with the commission an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration." ESource's original notice anniversary date is October 11, 2010 and therefore it is required to refile an up-to-date written notice on or before **August 12, 2012** if it continues to offer and provide electric aggregation service. In addition, Fawcett Energy Partners, Inc. is subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.08, customer protections provided by aggregators.
