Dear Ms. Howland:

Please accept this supplemental information to South Jersey Energy Company's ("SJE") application to become a Competitive Natural Gas Supplier in the state of New Hampshire.

In our application dated October 22, 2010, SJE requested a waiver of the requirement of Puc 3003.01(d)(2) which requires that we be an "approved shipper on the upstream pipelines and underground storage facilities on which the LDC will assign capacity, if any to the CNGS." SJE hereby withdraws its request for the waiver of this requirement. SJE is in the process of becoming an approved shipper on Tennessee Gas Pipeline (Tennessee). We are currently working on the Parental Guaranty, and as soon as that is executed, we will be an approved shipper. SJEI will forward the agreement to the PUC as soon as it is finalized.

As required by the regulations in Puc 3003.01, SJE has filed its application with the Commission on 10/22/2010 in the form specified by Puc 3006.01. SJE has not attempted to sell or offer to sell via mass media marketing in New Hampshire, and will not do so until approved by the NH PUC.

SJE has previously posted a surety bond and registration fee with its previous application in Docket No. DM10-203. SJE requests that this bond and application fee be transferred to this current application at Docket No. DM10-297.

SJE has served notice on Unitil/Northern Utilities and National Grid NH/ Energy North Natural Gas Inc. of its application to the NH PUC to become a licensed supplier. Copies of the notifications are attached.

I have been in contact with Bob Wyatt from your offices, and he is aware that we are in the midst of this approval process with Tennessee. He stated that he is holding our application for approval until we complete the items he has identified.
