

The New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc. proposes to change its current rates by changing its Stranded Cost Charge rate component effective with bills rendered on or after January 1, 2011. The effect of this Proposal, if there were no other rates changes, would be a decrease of 2.49% in total average revenue per kWh.
