In support of its request to increase its annual revenue requirement, Lakeland states that permanent rate increases are necessary given that the operating results for the test year ending December 31, 2010 reflect a loss of \$18,213. Lakeland further states that its last rate filing was 15 years ago and since then it has improved its water treatment systems, drilled a new well, and increased its storage capacity. Lakeland states that the increased cost of regulation, overall
