To the Parties:

On June 2, 2011, the City of Nashua, Pennichuck Corporation, Pennichuck Water Works, Inc., Pennichuck East Utility, Inc., and Pittsfield Aqueduct Company, Inc. (collectively, "Joint Petitioners") filed a motion to stay the procedural schedule in the above-referenced matter.
