Re: DM 11-038, Notification of Hospital Energy Services's Intent to Provide Electric Aggregation Service

Dear Mr. Mininberg:

This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received Hospital Energy Services's notice of intent to provide electric aggregation service in the State of New Hampshire, pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Rules Puc 2003.05. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.05. Based on Staff's recommendation and the Commission's review, the Commission approves Hospital Energy Services's application to provide electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.

Please note the following provision of Puc 2003.05 (f): "[E]ach approved aggregator shall re-notify the commission after the initial 2 year period, or after the 5 year renewal period as applicable, by filing with the commission an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration." Hospital Energy Services's original notice anniversary date is February 28, 2011 and therefore it is required to refile an up-to-date written notice on or before **January 1, 2013** if it continues to offer and provide electric aggregation service. In addition, Hospital Energy Services is subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.08, customer protections provided by aggregators.
