Dear Ms. Howland:

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. and/or Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp., enclosed for filing please find a revised Request to Terminate Service notice issued by either or both companies to National Grid. These are provided pursuant to Section V(C) (2) (b) of the Settlement Agreement in DG 11-040, approved by Order 25,370.

This notice addresses Security 1 – Site Security Services for both EnergyNorth Natural Gas and Granite State Electric. An initial Confirmation to Terminate Service was provided to the Commission on January 9, 2014. Subsequent to that filing, a previously undiscovered software anomaly prevented Liberty Utilities from completing the field work necessary for the transition. Liberty Utilities and National Grid worked collaboratively to resolve the problem while maintaining all required levels of security. The software issue has been resolved and all transition field work is now complete.
