

Dear Mr. Dziemian:

On March 8, 2011, White Columns Office Solutions LLC filed with the Commission an application for registration as a natural gas aggregator, together with the initial application fee of \$250.00. On March 18, 2011, after an earlier conversation with commission staff, filed a replacement Attachment A to the registration application.

The Commission has reviewed the application for registration as a natural gas aggregator and has determined that it meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.04. Therefore, the Commission will approve White Columns Office Solutions LLC as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to be effective April 1, 2011. This initial registration will expire at the end of business on March 31, 2013.


Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (a), each aggregator applicant shall re-register with the Commission by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of White Columns Office Solutions LLC, on or before February 1, 2013.
