Request for Waiver of Certain Provisions of Puc 2003.01 (h)

Dear Mr. Rodier,

On May 31, 2011, you filed on behalf of PNE Energy Supply LLC (PNE) a Motion to Extend Period for Completion of Application. Pursuant to New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2003.01 (h) information or clarification required by the Commission to complete an application for registration as a Competitive Electric Power Supplier must be provided by the applicant within 60 days of the request. According to your motion, an extension of time to allow PNE to complete its application would be in the public interest given the "unprecedented initiative of PNE to assemble an organization to serve residential customers in New Hampshire."

Pursuant to Puc 201.05(a), the Commission has determined that granting a partial waiver is in the public interest and will not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the Commission. Accordingly, the Commission will waive the filing requirements contained in Puc 2003.01 (h) and extend the time for PNE to complete its application to July 29, 2011. Please note that the Commission retains the authority to terminate its waiver if appropriate.
