On behalf Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES"), enclosed are an original and six (6) copies of: (1) a fully executed Settlement Agreement between UES and The Riverwoods Company at Exeter; and (2) a Stipulation for Docket Markings, also between UES and Riverwoods, which has been filed with the Rockingham County Superior Court. Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement, UES has paid RiverWoods the sum of one million four hundred fifty-nine thousand seven hundred twenty-one dollars (\$1,459,721).
