Dear Ms. Howland:

On May 13, 2011, Granite State Electric Company d/b/a National Grid submitted to the Commission its Reliability Enhancement Plan and Vegetation Management Plan Report and Reconciliation Filing. Table 4 of the Report states that 4 reclosers were completed in FY 2011. The column on Table 4 labeled "FY 2011 Actual Capital Investment (FERC 101/106) inadvertently omitted the costs of the fourth recloser.

The Company has updated the Report to include an additional \$86,291 in capital investment and \$3,829 in O&M associated with the fourth recloser. This has increased the Company's revenue requirement by \$19,776 and results in an additional one cent per month bill impact on customers. These changes are also reflected in revisions to the Pre-Filed Direct Testimony of Jennifer Grimsley and Jeffrey Carney and David E. Tufts (which has been adopted by Mr. Richer). I enclose an original and six copies of the revised Report and Testimony which shows all of the changes in redline.


