Enclosed please find Gorham Paper And Tissue, LLC's ("GPT") supplemental submission with regard to New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("NHPUC") review of its Natural Gas Pipeline Project. This package includes a Site Plan for the Metering and Regulating Station ("M&R Station") and updated plans showing the pipeline route.

These plans reflect some minor changes in the project description from those originally submitted with GPT's June 10, 2011 Petition. First, from the flange on the tap into the PNG natural gas transmission line to a location southwesterly of the M&R Station there will be a single pipe in the pipeline trench that will carry natural gas. At a point where GPT anticipates the natural gas pipeline will intersect the future landfill gas pipeline coming from the Androscoggin Valley Regional Refuse Disposal District ("District") the single trench will include a second, separate pipeline for landfill gas that is anticipated to connect to future development of the complete landfill gas pipeline. The landfill gas pipeline will not run through the M&R Station. Second, the location of the M&R Station has shifted roughly two hundred feet to the north in order to avoid the steep slope of the location shown on the plan submitted to you on June 10, 2011.
