Dear Director Howland:

Since its initial filing in this docket on June 17, 2011, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES") has received information from Northeast Utilities ("NU") that the revenue requirement effective June 1, 2011 is decreasing. This will result in a decrease in Third Party Transmission Provider costs of approximately \$271,000, which UES proposes to include in its EDC for effect August 1, 2011. In addition, because of this change, projected working capital for the period August 1, 2011-July 31, 2012 will decrease approximately \$3,000 compared to the amount previously filed.

Below is a summary the decrease in NU costs. The projected August 1, 2011 over-recovery should increase by about \$38,000 and the forecast costs for August 2011-July 2012 are expected to decrease by about \$232,000.
