Dear Ms. Weir:

On September 9, 2011, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Stetson Wind II, LLC (Stetson II) requesting certification as a Class I renewable energy source pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Staff has reviewed your application and has noted the following items that must be addressed before your application is considered complete:

- 1.) The application requires (#13) a description of the facility, including fuel type, gross nameplate generation capacity, the initial commercial operation date and the date it began operation if different. If this information was provided, I have not been able to locate it in the submitted materials.
- 2.) The statement of qualification from the State of Massachusetts refers to this facility as the Rollins Wind Plant. Please explain why the New Hampshire application uses different nomenclature.
- 3.) Please also clarify the ownership of the various facilities and the relationship(s) between Evergreen Wind Power (I&V), Rollins, and First Wind.

4.) The statement as to whether the facility's output has been verified by ISO-New England should be more formal than a hand written note. Please provide a separate attachment. An example from another applicant states: "______ is a ______ generator (identification number MSS37175) and its output is verified by the ISO New England."

These items must be received by the Commission to complete your application. Until such time, it will not be processed. Please also note that review of future applications would be greatly expedited if the references to attachments in the application provide more specific direction including specific page numbers.

If the requested information and documentation are not provided within ten business days, your file will be closed without prejudice. Please refer to docket number DE 11-182 in all future correspondence with the Commission. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
