Upon further review of your application staff has noted that Evergreen has not listed the proper ISO asset identification number for the applications for renewable energy certificates (RECs) listed above. The number listed in the document is simply the NEPOOL-GIS database number minus the letter code used by the NEPOOL-GIS. Since other state REC programs require the ISO asset identification number, it is likely that you have already gone through the process to obtain it. If that search doesn't yield a number, I did some looking on the web and I found the following contact at ISO-NE at http://www.iso-ne.com/support/reg_info/membership/index.html.
