Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Commission's Order No. 25,281, enclosed is an original copy of the monthly calculation of the projected (over)/under collection for the 2011-2012 winter period.

The computations are based on actual costs and revenues through February and forecasts for the remainder of the period. The calculations show a projected over-collection through April 30, 2012 of \$6,579 and would necessitate a \$0.0684 decrease to the current Non-FPO Cost of Gas Rate of \$2.1684, resulting in a revised Non-FPO COG Rate of \$2.1000 per therm.

The Company does not elect to implement the forecasted decrease for the April 1<sup>st</sup> billing cycle.
