On October 27, 2011, Aquarion filed its 2011 Water Infrastructure and Conservation Adjustment (WICA) filing. On November 8, 2011, Staff contacted the Town of Hampton, the Town of North Hampton, the Town of Rye, the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and Aquarion and proposed a procedural schedule for review of the filing. The Town of Hampton has indicated that it will be participating, but as of this date, Staff has not heard back from North Hampton or Rye. The OCA has indicated that it likely will not participate. Staff and Aquarion propose the following procedural schedule for the Commission's consideration.
