

**1. Tariff Information and General Regulations****1.7 Surcharges**

<b>1.7.1 Enhanced Universal Emergency Number (E911)</b>	
<b>A.</b>	An E911 surcharge applies per month to each residence and business telephone exchange line, including PBX trunks and Centrex lines, PASL and public access lines in addition to the monthly rates for these lines.
<b>1.</b>	The surcharge shall not be imposed upon more than 25 lines per customer billing account.

<b>1.7.2 Municipal Property Tax Surcharge</b>	
<b>A.</b>	A Municipal Property Tax Surcharge applies per month to each residence and business telephone exchange line, including PBX trunks and Centrex lines, PASL and public access lines in addition to the monthly rates for these lines. This surcharge recovers the amount of municipal property taxes billed to the Company for telephone poles, conduit and use of municipal right-of-ways.
<b>1.</b>	The surcharge shall not be imposed upon more than 25 lines per customer billing account.

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**7. Surcharges****7.1 Municipal Property Tax Surcharge**

<b>7.1.1 Description</b>	
<b>A.</b>	A Municipal Property Tax Surcharge applies per month to each residence and business telephone exchange line, including PBX trunks and Centrex lines, PASL and public access lines sold under this tariff in addition to the monthly rates for these lines. This surcharge recovers the amount of municipal property taxes billed to the Company for telephone poles, conduit and use of municipal right-of-ways.
<b>B.</b>	The Telephone Company will bill the reseller the Municipal Property Tax Surcharge. The Municipal Property Tax Surcharge is not subject to the resale discount.
