Effective: April 16, 2012

In its Order No. 25,346 the Commission approved an increase of 0.44 cents per kilowatt-hour to PSNH's Energy Service rate effective April 16, 2012 (from 8.31 cents per kilowatt-hour to 8.75 cents per kilowatt-hour). Overall, this rate change will result in an annual revenue increase of approximately \$33.6 million or 2.9 percent.

In lieu of filing black-lined tariff pages denoting the rate change, PSNH has enclosed a report entitled "Summary of Rates Effective January 1, 2012 and April 16, 2012" which compares the currently effective rates (April 16, 2012) with the rates previously in effect by rate component and rate schedule so that the rate changes can be easily identified by rate schedule.

Supplemental Information on the Filing


The enclosed "Summary of Rates Effective April 16, 2012" report shows, by rate class and rate component, all rates and charges in PSNH's tariff. In addition, we have enclosed a schedule of "Typical Bill Comparisons" based on the existing rates and the new rates. The Residential Delivery Service Rate R monthly bill for 500 kilowatt-hours (with no water heating) previously \$86.86, will increase by \$2.20 to \$89.06 on April 16, 2012, or by 2.6 percent.

Customer Notification

A message will be placed on customers' bills rendered on or after April 16, 2012 informing them of the rate change. In addition, an article describing the rate change in greater detail will be placed in PSNH's "Living with Energy" bill insert and will be included with customers' bills rendered on or after May 16, 2012.
