

- For responses up to 10 megabytes in size, it will provide those responses electronically;
- For responses greater than 10 megabytes but less than 200 pages, it will provide a hard copy to the requesting party, with copies to other parties upon request; and
- For responses greater than 10 megabytes and more than 200 pages (including engineering drawings or other documents that are not easily photocopied or scanned), PSNH would establish a physical data room to allow parties to view the documents and to make copies on a case-by-case basis as may be requested.

PSNH's proposal has not been accepted by all of the parties to the docket, particularly with respect to the establishment of a physical data room. Staff intends to continue working with the parties and PSNH to see if an agreement can be reached on the details regarding discovery and will keep the Commission apprised of any developments or issues that require Commission attention.
