Response:

Any data may have a place in a prudent utility business planning process, depending upon the facts. Facts accepted by the NHPUC are certainly valuable for understanding what the Commission deems to be reasonable and prudent. PSNH may examine regional or national agency data, or industry data to validate any assumption.
