Dear Ms. Howland:

On December 28, 2011, the Commission held a prehearing conference in the above-captioned docket. The Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed a letter with the Commission stating that it would participate in this docket on behalf of residential ratepayers pursuant to RSA 363:28. No petitions to intervene were filed.

At the prehearing conference, Staff said that it would be holding a technical session on January 6, 2012 to review the renewable energy service option (RESO) tariff proposed by Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) in this docket and, generally, the RESO program of PSNH, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. and Granite State Electric Company d/b/a National Grid. Staff informed the Commission that the OCA is aware of the proposed January 6, 2012 technical session.

Following the prehearing conference, PSNH and Staff met in technical session to discuss a proposed procedural schedule. Staff agreed to submit data requests before the January 6 technical session. Staff does not anticipate the need to file testimony in this proceeding, however, the OCA was unable to attend the prehearing conference and if as a result any changes need to be made to this truncated procedural schedule Staff will so promptly inform the Commission. The proposed procedural schedule is as follows:

Technical Session (all companies)	January 6, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.
Merits hearing (DE 11-255 only)	January 26, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.
