Dear Ms. Howland:

Pursuant to the Commission's registration requirements, Secure Energy Solutions, LLC (the "Company"), hereby files its Initial Registration Application and supporting documentation for your consideration, along with its application fee of \$250.00. As required, we have provided an original and two copies along with an electronic eopy in PDF format.

As required under PUC 3006.02 (a) of the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, the Company has attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**, its responses to the Aggregator Initial Registration Application Questions.

In addition to the information provided in its application materials, the Company offers the following supplemental information in support of its application. The Company has been registered to do business in New Hampshire since 2006 and since that time, has been a Registered Provider of Electric Aggregation Service. The Company's main office is located in East Longmeadow, Massachusetts and it operates a satellite office in Montville, New Jersey. In addition to the three owners who each remain active in the day-to-day operations, the Company has recently retained a full-time General Counsel to, among other things, handle regulatory compliance matters and interact with its more sophisticated customer's legal advisors.

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The Company is dedicated to customer service and maintains a strict Total Quality Management ("TQM") program requiring its sales staff to routinely interact with its customers after they enter into supplier agreements. The Company has a current staff of 25 employees between its two offices.

In connection with this application, it has come to our attention that the Company has, through one of its sales representatives, unwittingly violated Section 3003.04 (a) which states that "No aggregator shall enroll customers, or arrange to sell to or contract with customers, or solicit specific customers for such purposes until such aggregator has completed all aspects of registration required by PUC 3003." In this regard, a Company agent sold and renewed a single natural gas contract with a customer located in New Hampshire in June 2009 within the Keyspan/Energy North territory (the contract was renewed in July 2010). The sales representative was aware of our registration as a Registered Provider of Electric Aggregation Services and unwittingly assumed that the Company's registration authorized the sale of natural gas as well. This staff member and all of the Company's staff have been notified of this incident, and procedures have been put in place to prevent this from happening in the future. The Company regrets this error, and has voluntarily disclosed this information for the Commission's consideration. In particular, the Company's General Counsel, Erik J. Ness, reported the incident to Robert Wyatt, Utility Analyst IV, on November 21, 2011.
