As I indicated during our phone conversation, Atlantic Power Partners LLC's application to be registered as an aggregator is not complete. Pursuant to Puc 2006.02(5), A copy of the applicant's authorization to do business in New Hampshire from the secretary of state is required which you did not provide with your application. Please bear in mind that Puc 2003.04 (h) states:

"If the commission has requested information or clarification to complete the application for notification, and such information or clarification is not provided within 60 days of the request, the commission shall suspend the application. If, after 120 days of the date of the request, the applicant has not provided the requested information or clarification, the commission shall reject the application. If an application is rejected, the application fee shall be forfeited and the applicant shall be required to submit a new application and fee prior to acting as an aggregator in New Hampshire".

Please file the required document within 60 days of receiving this letter/e-mail so that the Commission can proceed with the registration process.
