We are responding to your letter dated May 16, 2012 regarding the SREC Generating Company's ("SREC") application of March 6, 2012 and this response is our compliance submittal.

Your letter indicates a requirement for SREC to submit its existing Interconnection Agreement ("IA") to demonstrate that its generation in the application currently has an effective interconnection agreement. The effective IA is dated October 6, 2010 and was executed by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Steuben Rural Electric Cooperative, Inc. In compliance with your request we have attached a redacted version of the IA and also sent six copies to Debra A. Howland, Commission's Executive Director. Our redacted version was developed pursuant to the "Adopted Final Rule 2011-113, Puc 100-Puc 200 Rules of Practice and Procedure (incl. Confidentiality).
