Dear Messrs. Desbiens \& Taylor:
On April 24, 2012, NHOS filed a petition pursuant to RSA 371:17 seeking approval for licenses to construct and maintain fiber optic communications cable over and across one public waterway and two railroads, in a section of cable line that begins in Littleton and ends in Lancaster, otherwise referred to as Segment 6 of the project.

Staff investigation revealed that all rail tracks in the town of Whitefield are considered active, although at present there is no demand for service.

Following staff review, it was determined that existing cables at both railroad crossings, i.e.

- Union Street, Whitefield, NH (designated TID 127) E-42/19-T-196/1; E-42/20-T-196C/2, and
- Lancaster Road, Whitefield, NH (designated TID 128) E-42/14-T-1/5; E-42/15-T-1/4.5
may not be in compliance with NESC under heavy load conditions. Please investigate the two crossings and determine whether they are in compliance or take remedial action to rectify the problem.

In the event facilities need to be relocated in order to comply, please perform the work immediately, and provide NHOS with appropriate attachment instructions, and additionally notify Staff by letter in this docket when the investigation and work, if necessary is complete. Please include the Order number granting your license to cross state land at this location in your letter.
