Re: DE 12-114, The Hamilton Residence Application Requesting Class II Eligibility for Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) Generated by the 4600 kW Photovoltaic Array at 47 Mariette Drive, Portsmouth, NH 03801-6068, Pursuant to RSA 362-F.

Dear Mr. Hamilton:

On April 30, 2012, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from you requesting certification of your photovoltaic array at 47 Mariette Drive, Portsmouth, as a Class I renewable energy source pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law.

Your original application lists your nameplate capacity as 4600 kilowatts (kW). On May 11, 2012, the Commission received an amendment to your application for certification as a REC Eligible Facility that states that as of May 4, 2012 three more solar PV panels have been added. No information was provided on the new output of the system. In order to complete review of your application and recommend approval, it is imperative that the Commission receive an updated interconnection application and service agreement. This document will also verify the new total output of your photovoltaic array.

Submission of the above modification and verification must be received by the Commission to complete your application. Until such time, it cannot be processed. If the requested information and documentation are not provided within ten business days of the date of this letter, your application will be denied without prejudice. Please refer to docket number **DE 12-114** in all future correspondence with the Commission.
