**Re: Intrastate Access Service Tariff Filing**

Dear Ms. Howland:

Northland Telephone Company of Maine, Inc. d/b/a FairPoint Communications (“FairPoint”) hereby files a complete copy of its intrastate Access Service Tariff for effect May 31, 2012. FairPoint has utilized historical copies from paper and electronic files as well as information from the Northland Telephone Company of Maine tariffs for Maine to furnish a complete version of its intrastate Access Service Tariff for New Hampshire. This filing is being proposed and is necessary to update the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“NHPUC”) with a complete intrastate Access Service Tariff. FairPoint respectfully requests the NHPUC accept this Access Service Tariff in its entirety as an original document with an effective date of May 31, 2012.

This filing also reflects certain revisions to the FairPoint’s intrastate Access Service Tariff incorporating the requirements of the Federal Communications Commission Report and Order in WC Docket No. 10-90, et. al., FCC No. 11-161, released November 18, 2011 regarding the treatment of Toll VoIP-PSTN traffic. The NHPUC approved the exact language changes in Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC d/b/a/ FairPoint Communications’ – NNE revisions to its NHPUC Tariff No. 3 filed December 23, 2011. The Secretarial Letter was issued January 26, 2012 in Docket DT 11-289.

Included in this filing are certain other necessary administrative changes. FairPoint’s name is now consistent on all pages and all references to its interstate Access Tariff were changed from NECA 5 to F.C.C. Tariff No. 2. FairPoint is making every page an original consistent with the proposed changes referenced above.

The need to file a complete intrastate Access Service Tariff was reviewed with the NHPUC Staff earlier today. Attached are copies of the tariff pages. Please return the copy of this filing marked “Receipt” with your stamp of receipt, and feel free to call me with any questions at 603.656.8102.
