NOW, THEREFORE, Upon notice from Obligee of Principal's nonperformance of its duties as a New Hampshire CEPS, or Principal's fraud or other violations of the laws, decisions and orders applicable to Principal's CEPS license, Surety shall immediately pay to Obligee the amount specified by Obligee, not to exceed the amount of this Bond. This Bond shall remain in full force and effect for the term set forth below unless terminated as provided below.

This Bond is subject to the following terms, limitations and conditions:

- 1. The term of this Bond shall be for one year commencing on the date hereof, unless terminated in accordance with paragraph 2 below or replaced by a successor Bond prior to the end of the term. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Bond may not be terminated prior to twelve (12) months after the date hereof without ninety (90) days prior written notice to the Obligee or the written consent of the Obligee ("Term").
- 2. That no proceeding in law or in equity may be brought under this Bond unless the same shall be commenced and process served prior to the expiration of one (1) year from the date of cancellation of this Bond.
