The rules certain requirements for the operation of gas utilities and gas pipelines. The rules also require certain reporting requirements for gas utilities and certain procedures for the enforcement of the rules, including penalties. These rules establish requirements for the operation of gas utilities, including gas pipeline safety requirements. The proposal represents an adoption of current rules with amendment. The proposal amends the existing rule by allowing meters to be tested by sample; bringing the rules in alignment with the federal standards for the transportation of gas by pipeline; streamlining and eliminating some reporting requirements, and adding some reporting requirements based on the issues that have been brought to the Commission's attention in recent dockets. In addition, the proposal strengthens regulation of liquid petroleum gas (LPG) operations.
