Dear Mr. Mobilia:

As you know, on June 18, 2006, you filed a petition to dissolve Lakeview Water Company, Inc. As you also know, the lots within Bachelor Mountain subdivision were approved by the Department of Environmental Services upon the condition that community water be provided. The lots cannot, without an amendment to the original subdivision support private potable wells. This condition is an impediment to dissolution of the water system.

Staff is aware you were going to contact a consultant about filing an amended subdivision application, however, it has been some months since our last communication with you. At this time, could you kindly provide us with an update on your progress toward lifting this condition on customer lots? If you are not lifting this condition and your plans to dissolve have changed, we would appreciate knowing that as well.
