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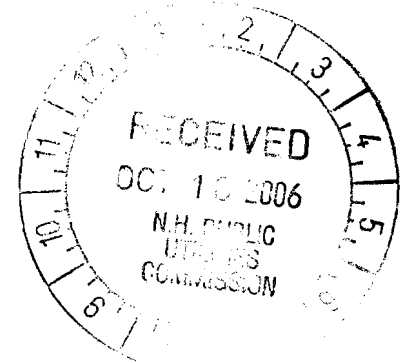

Dear Ms. Howland:

Staff, Pennichuck East Utilities, Inc. (PEU), Ms. Sandra Crane, and Felix Quintal met in a technical session following Thursday's prehearing conference. During the discussions, it became evident that the boundary line shown on PEU's surveyed maps differed from the boundary line shown on a survey Mr. Quintal had done a few years ago. PEU agreed to use the boundary Mr. Quintal agreed to and that change resulted in PEU not needing to pursue an easement from Mr. Quintal.

PEU is still pursuing an easement from Ms. Crane and those two parties have agreed to discuss easement language. Further, PEU has agreed to pay for up to four hours of attorney time Ms. Crane may need to review the proposed easement. PEU expects to report back to the Commission within forty-five (45) days on whether they will pursue Commission action on their condemnation petition or, if agreement is reached with Ms. Crane, seek to withdraw the petition.

Staff will continue to closely monitor these events as to Ms. Crane and Mr. Quintal and will make a recommendation regarding the disposition this matter at a later date. Thank you.
