Correction of Response to MCT and KTC's responses to Oral Data Requests**

Dear Ms. Howland:

Yesterday, I filed a letter responding to MCT and KTC's responses to Oral Data Requests. After reviewing the transcript from the hearing on October 1, 2009, in this docket, which I received yesterday, I realized that my letter contains a misstatement of fact. I write today to correct that misstatement.

Specifically, my letter yesterday included the following statements:

... Michael Reed made "one minor change" to his prefiled Supplemental testimony. *See* Transcript of Hearing on September 29, 2009, p. 41, line 18, through p. 42, line 5 ... Mr. Reed added the KTC exchange of Andover to the exchanges that the Companies contend have a cable alternative to TDS ... *the hearing on the merits in phase 2 was the first time that the Company included this assertion as part of its case before the Commission.*

OCA Response to MCT and KTC responses to Oral Data Requests, p. 2 (emphasis added). Actually, the Company included this assertion at least as early as Mr. Reed's Rebutal testimony filed in November 2007. *See* Reed Rebuttal Testimony dated November 15, 2007, at p. 6, lines 5-22.

Please accept my apology for this error and any resulting confusion. To be clear, this correction does not change the position of the OCA as otherwise expressed in the letter filed yesterday. Thank you.
