Daniel Bailey replies to the Response of Kearsarge and Merrimack County Telephone Companies (hereinafter, the “TDS Companies”) as follows:

1. By Response dated February 11, 2009 the TDS Companies object to the standing of Daniel Bailey with respect to Kearsarge Telephone Company.
2. In Order No. 24,885 dated August 8, 2008, entitled Order Denying Motion For Rehearing, the Commission ruled that Mr. Bailey has standing with respect to Kearsarge Telephone Company as well as Merrimack County Telephone Company. Order, pages 9 – 12.
3. The TDS Companies have not alleged any new facts that may have changed Mr. Bailey’s standing regarding Kearsarge Telephone Company.

4. The above Order is a final order. The TDS Companies did not appeal.
5. For the reasons set forth herein, Mr. Bailey has standing to participate regarding Kearsarge Telephone Company.

Wherefore, Daniel Bailey respectfully requests that the Commission dismiss the TDS Companies' objection and grant such other relief as is reasonable and just.
