RE: DT 09-044, DT 12-308; Letter Concerning the Scope of DT 12-308

Dear Secretary Howland:

We just recently became aware of the New Hampshire Supreme Court's October 12, 2012 decision in <u>Appeal of Comcast Phone of New Hampshire</u>, <u>LLC &</u> <u>a.</u>, Case No. 2011-0762, which followed an appeal from the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) decisions in DT 09-044. In response to the New Hampshire Supreme Court's recent decision, the Commission opened a new docket, DT 12-308, issuing an Order of Notice setting forth several questions regarding the implication of Senate Bill 48 on Commission regulation. <u>See</u> Order of Notice, DT 12-308, pp. 2-3.

We write to respectfully caution the Commission on the scope of the issues it addresses in this matter. The New Hampshire Supreme Court decided:

> The case is remanded to the Public Utilities Commission for the limited purpose of allowing it to reconsider Order No. 25,262 and Order No. 25, 274, and any related orders in docket no. DT 09-044, in light of Laws 2012, chapter 177.

<u>Appeal of Comcast Phone of New Hampshire, LLC & a.</u>, Case No. 2011-0762, October 12, 2012 Order. The scope of DT 09-044 was previously articulated by the Commission as follows:

This docket considers whether cable voice service in general, and Comcast Digital Voice and Time Warner's Digital Phone and Business Class Phone, in particular, constitute conveyance of a telephone message under RSA 362:2, whether providers of such services are public

utilities, and the extent to which federal law preempts New Hampshire law with regard to such services.

Order No. 25,262, p. 2.

We believe the scope of the matter before the Commission should be limited to an evaluation of the impact of Senate Bill 48 on Comcast Digital Voice and Time Warner's Digital Phone and Business Class Phone. We do not believe this evaluation needs to include a broad evaluation of the cable industry in general.

We certainly do not believe the scope of the matter before the Commission should extend in any way to an evaluation of the impact of Senate Bill 48 on Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers (ILECs) existing at the time of Senate Bill 48's effective date.

We respectfully suggest that these broader issues are better addressed in rulemaking, including, but not limited to, in DRM 12-036.
