


On June 11, 2012, Governor John H. Lynch signed into law New Hampshire Senate Bill 48 which, among other things, deregulated rates and charges for end user telecommunications services as of August 10, 2012. Accordingly, FairPoint is withdrawing its NHPUC Tariff No.1 effective October 23, 2012, which will be filed under separate cover. The revisions in this NHPUC No. 4 Resale Tariff filing reflect language changes that are required as a result of the withdrawal of the NHPUC No. 1 Retail Tariff.
