

Re: DT 12-323 Administrative Filing

Dear Ms. Howland:

On October 23, 2012, Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC d/b/a FairPoint Communications – NNE (“FairPoint”) filed for effect November 23, 2012 tariff changes consisting of 131 pages to its NHPUC No. 2 Wholesale Tariff. These changes were required when on June 11, 2012, Governor John H. Lynch signed into law New Hampshire Senate Bill 48 which, among other things, deregulated rates and charges for end user telecommunications services as of August 10, 2012. That filing also made changes to the Tariff consistent with the Orders of the Federal Communication Commission; See *Triennial Review Order* (“TRO”), 18 F.C.C.R. 16978 (2003) and the *Triennial Review Remand Order* (“TRRO”) 20 F.C.C.R. 2533 (2005); and the ruling of the 1st Circuit Court of Appeals in *Verizon New England v. Maine Public Utilities Commission*, 509 F.3d 1 (1st Circuit 2007).

This filing makes administrative updates, to correct certain margin and page revision designations only, to seven pages originally included in the October 23, 2012 filing. FairPoint has discussed these changes in recent communications with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission’s Staff. FairPoint respectfully requests a waiver of PUC 1603.07 and asks for less than 30 days approval, keeping the original filing effective date of November 23, 2012.
