Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC d/b/a FairPoint Communications – NNE (“FairPoint”) is filing for effect December 16, 2012 tariff changes consisting of:

These changes implement certain provisions of the *Order on Remand* issued by the Federal Communications Commission on February 4, 2005, in WC Docket No. 04-313 and CC Docket No. 01-338 (the “*Triennial Review Remand Order*”) by designating certain wire centers as unimpaired for UNE dark fiber, DS1 and DS3 Interoffice Transport.

The tariff filing support package contains proprietary information. Copies are being provided under seal to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission and to the Office of Consumer Advocate for review by their staffs.
