Dear Ms. Howland:

The Legislative Oversight Committee on Electric Utility Restructuring is in receipt of your letter of October 25, 2013 and wishes to thank you for your response. The Committee now better understands the amount of time you will require to fully investigate the economic value of PSNH's generation assets to its retail customers. Even though it appears that you will not be able to complete such an investigation by April 1, 2014, we do believe that the information and reports you detail in your letter would be of great value to the New Hampshire General Court in its deliberations during the upcoming legislative session.

Accordingly, the Committee modifies its earlier request to now ask for a preliminary status report of your investigation by April 1, 2014, or earlier if feasible, that would include at a minimum the Commission's staff position on this issue, the associated analysis of any independent consultants, and any recommendations for legislation that may be needed to move the process forward.
