On February 25, 2013, Competitive Energy Services, LLC submitted an application on behalf of the Manchester – Boston Regional Airport (MHT) seeking certification of the electrical production from the photovoltaic (PV) array located on the rooftop of MHT's main parking garage for Class II renewable energy certificates (RECs), pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) law. Staff has determined the application was complete in the initial filing in accordance with New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2500. The application and all submitted information have been reviewed and staff recommends approval effective February 25, 2013.

Class II eligibility requires a facility to produce electricity from solar technologies and to have initiated operation after January 01, 2006. The application indicates that the MHT PV array began operation on June 21, 2012; the total nameplate capacity of the PV array is 0.5 MW; the facility's New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Generation Information System facility code is NON36096.

Pursuant to Puc 2502.13, the MHT PV array is a customer-sited photovoltaic facility; therefore, its output is not recorded in the NEPOOL Market Settlement System and, as a result, must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application states that Thomas Kelly will serve as the facility's independent monitor as required by the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08(b)(5).

Staff has determined that all necessary information has been provided to demonstrate the MHT PV array's eligibility for certification to produce New Hampshire Class II RECs. Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission hereby certifies the MHT PV array as a Class II renewable energy source effective February 25, 2013. The New Hampshire single certification code for the MHT PV array is NH-II-13-027.
