

Re: Petition of Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC d/b/a FairPoint Communications – NNE ("FairPoint") to Construct and Maintain Temporary Telecommunications Cables across New Hampshire Public Waters

Dear Ms. Howland:

FairPoint has been contacted by the State of New Hampshire ("the State") in regards to a bridge reconstruction project on-going in Somersworth, New Hampshire. As part of this project, FairPoint is required to re-locate its telecommunications facilities over New Hampshire public waters in order to allow the State to advance the project.

Included with this letter is a petition for FairPoint to construct and maintain its telecommunications cables on a temporary basis over New Hampshire public waters. FairPoint's cables will be attached to existing utility poles that have wires crossing over the same waterway. Upon completion of the bridge reconstruction project, FairPoint will remove its temporary cables and permanently attach to the redesigned bridge in a conduit system.
