Staff is writing in response to the motion to dismiss by Resident Power Natural Gas & Electric Solutions LLC ("Resident Power"), regarding the consolidated investigative and show cause proceeding for the above-captioned dockets, filed by Resident Power at approximately 6:00 p.m. on March 21, 2013.

Staff wishes to inform the Commission that the Commission's dismissal of all Staff allegations against Resident Power, and any concomitant release of Resident Power from the obligation to appear before the Commission at the public hearing scheduled for the instant proceeding, would not be warranted. This consolidated proceeding has an investigatory component, involving Resident Power's alleged actions and omissions, that must proceed irrespective of whether sanctions would be imposed by the Commission for such alleged actions and omissions. The Commission is empowered in any instance to make findings of violations of Commission rules by Resident Power, as a registered electric aggregator, irrespective of the Commission's power to issue sanctions for such violations.
